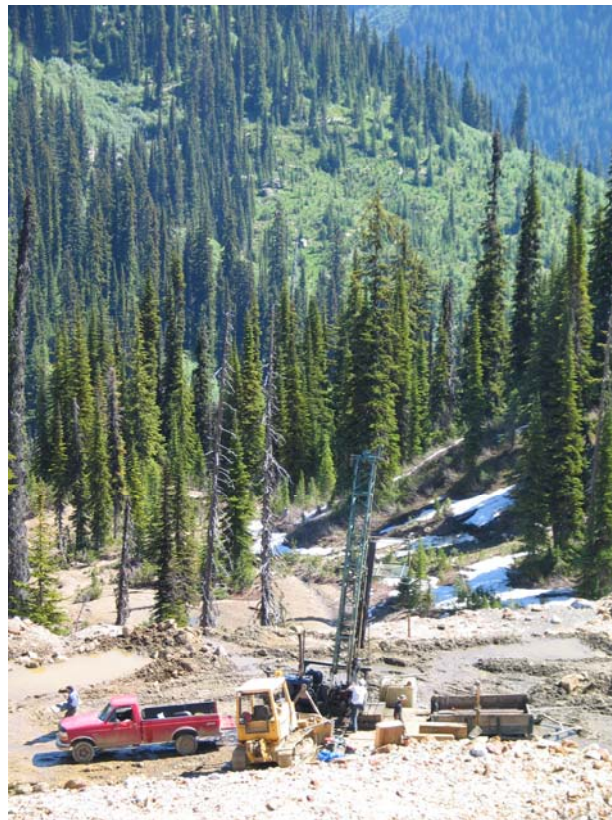

**Taranis Resources Inc.** ("Taranis") [TSX.V: TRO] is a Colorado-based resource company exploring a number of exploration projects in Canada, Nevada and Finland. Taranis is actively exploring the Thor property in British Columbia and the Midway East Project located in Nevada.

Taranis has also formed a Strategic Alliance with Royal Gold, Inc. of Denver to further explore the Kettukuusikko Project in Finland, and to seek other advance-stage gold projects in Finland.

## **Taranis Property Overviews:**

**Thor:** The 100%-owned Thor property was acquired in early 2007 by Taranis after due diligence on the property identified widespread base and precious metal mineralization over a strike length of 1,400m. A phase one diamond drilling program consisting of 60 diamond drill holes demonstrated further widespread mineralization on the property, and Taranis plans to accelerate the exploration of the property in 2007 using multiple drill rigs. An "in-house" resource calculation completed in 2007 suggests that the property has potential to host a sizeable base/precious metal deposit that could be mined through conventional open-pit and underground methods. A number of high-priority geophysical targets were located, the most important of which appears to be the "50-0-50" coincident magnetic and electromagnetic anomaly that occurs down-dip of all the existing mineralization on the property, and has never been tested.

## **Midway East:**

This 100% owned property consists of 60 Bureau of Land Management claims located over a major gravity feature in Ralston Valley. Taranis has contracted WMC drilling to undertake a drill program aimed at identifying epithermal gold and silver mineralization concealed under a thin layer of colluvium.

## **Kettukuusikko:**

Taranis has also undertaken widespread exploration at its Kettukuusikko Project, located in Finland. Taranis is currently in the process of renewing a number of the Mining Claims at Kettukuusikko.

**Tybo West:** Taranis has completed a number of geotechnical surveys including geochemistry and geophysics on the property aimed at locating additional gold & silver mineralization. Targets identified from these surveys were tested with a drill program in 2004, and a number of significant gold intercepts (epithermal) were identified within the Dimick Epithermal Trend that warrant additional follow-up.

**Caselton East:** The Caselton East property, consisting of 77 BLM claims, is located in close proximity to the historic Pioche mining district. Ground magnetic and VLF surveys completed late in 2005 have identified several drill targets associated with faults and possible buried intrusive bodies.
