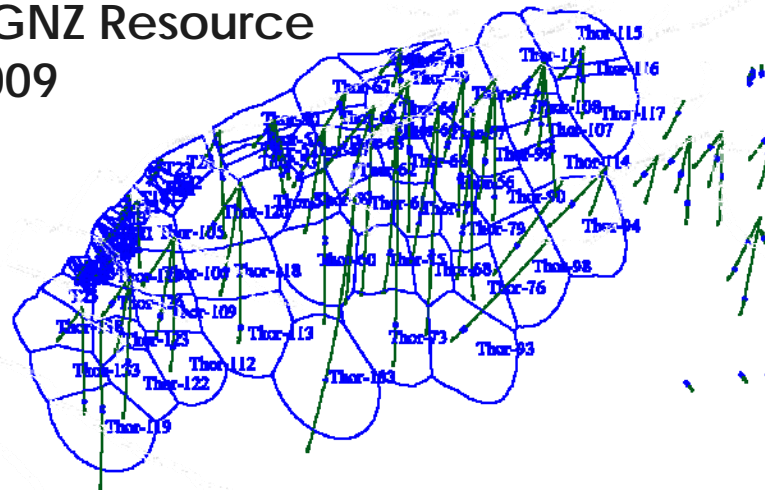
Taranis Gets Approval for
Kettukuusikko Mining
Claims in Finland and
Amends Finland Regional
Exploration Agreement
with Royal Gold, Inc.

The Kettukuusikko project in Finland is jointly explored with Royal Gold, Inc., a well-funded royalty company based in Denver. Taranis and Royal Gold, Inc. also have a strategic alliance exploring a number of other gold exploration properties in Finland.

Taranis Property Overviews:

Thor: The Thor project was acquired in January 2007, and has been subjected to diamond drilling in the summers of 2007 and 2008. Taranis has completed a total of 152 drill holes totaling 36,000 ft on the Broadview, Great Northern, True Fissure and St. Elmo/Blue Bell zones. Considerable exploration remains north of the known mineralized zones at Thor!

Kettukuusikko: The Kettukuusikko project was acquired in late 2004 after the Geological Survey of Finland ("GTK") put the property up for international tender. Taranis has drilled 93 holes at Kettukuusikko totaling 8,997 meters. The GTK and Outokumpu completed an additional 3,947 m of drilling. Towards the end of the 2006 drilling program, drill hole K-29 intersected 4.33 g/t/20.35 m. In the same year, Taranis discovered a new zone called the Kettukuusikko North Zone that hosts extremely high-grade gold values (up to 27.72 g/t Au / 1.82 m) and has been traced for over 100 m with diamond drilling. Taranis plans on undertaking a drill program in April 2009 (time permitting).
