

Taranis Plans Further Work on Three Areas in Nevada Identified From the DiRT Program

Lakewood, Colorado, February 3, 2010 – Taranis Resources Inc. ("Taranis") [TSX.V: TRO], is pleased to announce an update of its 2010 DiRT exploration program.

After completing the gravity surveys covering approximately 859 square km, at least three target areas were identified warranting further investigation by ground magnetic and other geophysical surveys to pinpoint drill targets on these exciting opportunities. Taranis will continue to advance thee projects in-house, since they are potentially "district scale" targets having enormous implications for our shareholders.

John Gardiner further comments "Taranis is also considering strategic business partners enabling Taranis to advance these opportunities through drill testing while sharing some of the capital risk. Nevada' gold deposits tend to be substantial in size, and could easily support a partner that would also capitalize on Taranis' exploration efforts."
